



The 2017 Reid Sound Scholarship for Theatrical Technicians

The Reid Sound Scholarship for Theatrical Technicians is a \$1,500 award which will be given to one New Jersey high school senior who plans to pursue a technical theater major at a two- or four-year college or university.

The award, sponsored by Reid Sound, Inc, was created to recognize the efforts and contributions of students who work behind-the-scenes, often working as hard as the performers on-stage but receiving little public acknowledgement.

Applicants will be evaluated based on their skill and dedication to the art of technical theater, as demonstrated through their experiences, recommendations and responses to the questions on the scholarship application. For the purposes of the scholarship, valid experiences include participation with sound, lighting, costume or set design, stage management or running crew.

To qualify for the Reid Sound Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a senior at a high school in the state of New Jersey, graduating no later than July 31, 2017
- Be an active participant in technical theater activities, either at their high school or through outside groups
- Plan to enroll in a technical theater major at a two- or four-year college or university for the Fall 2017 semester

Interested students should complete the attached scholarship application. Additional supporting information will be required, including a resume of technical theater activities, an official high school transcript, and two letters of recommendation – please refer to the application for specific requirements. You may also send any optional supporting materials (photos, design sketches, etc...), but note that any materials submitted will *not* be returned. All applications and supporting material must be received by Reid Sound no later than May 1, 2017.

Applications will be evaluated by a selection committee appointed by Reid Sound, Inc. Applicants will be notified of their status in the scholarship program no later than June 15.

You may attach a resume you previously created for submission to colleges/universities as long as the required information for each production is provided. You are also welcome to provide examples from your portfolio in support of your application (see program description for more information).

Briefly discuss the moment at which you discovered your passion for technical theater. What was your primary influence for choosing technical theater as a profession?

RECOMMENDATION & TRANSCRIPT REQUIREMENT

Two letters of recommendation are required:

- The first letter of recommendation should be provided by a guidance counselor or teacher who is familiar with your academic progress.
- The second letter of recommendation should be provided by a source familiar with your technical theater activities.

All letters of recommendation must be provided by objective third parties. Recommendations provided by friends, classmates or family members *will not be considered*.

You are also required to submit a **complete, official high school transcript** (through December 31, 2016) including classes currently in-progress. You may obtain a copy of your transcript and/or letters of recommendation and submit with this application, or you may request that your high school sends the materials directly to the address below. Your transcript and letters of recommendation must be received by Reid Sound by the deadline date for the scholarship program.
